Kairos Best Practices Guide – Ascension

Kairos is a 3.5 day retreat led by seniors and Campus Ministers where the value of Christian faith is lived and celebrated in community. The purpose of this popular retreat is to help students identify and celebrate where God’s love is active in their lives. Boys and girls sleep on separate floors at Cabrini Retreat Center. Kairos Retreat | Saint Viator High School

Kairos Retreat. Named after the Greek word “kairos” referring to “the Lord’s time.” Kairos is a three-day, two-night, senior retreat led by a team of adult and student leaders. The program is designed around a series of talks by the Team Leaders, each of whom talks about a specific, pre-assigned topic.

Kairos Retreat - Roger Bacon High School - Cincinnati, Ohio

The retreat will be led by student leaders who have already made the retreat and who will guide the retreatants through reflection, discussion, and prayer that leads to a deeper awareness of God’s presence and blessing in their lives. The Kairos Retreat is a three-night, four-day retreat for juniors led by faculty and staff as well as selected seniors. The Kairos Retreat is offered to St. John Bosco High School seniors because they are, indeed, ripe, mature and prepared to enter the next phase of their faith development. Kairos is a unique moment in that development, not only for the candidates, but for the entire school community. During Kairos, the retreatants look carefully at themselves, their relationships with others, and their relationship with God.

Kairos Retreat - St. John Bosco High School

Kairos is a two-night, three-day experience open to all juniors. The retreat is led by a team of students and faculty or staff members who share reflections, lead meditations, and guide small group discussions about identity, spirituality, and personal growth. The retreat is typically held at Cradle Beach Camp, on Lake Erie, in Angola, New York.

Kairos Retreat - Canisius High School

KAIROS is a three day retreat for the 11 th and 12 th graders. This retreat helps them learn more about themselves, their relationships with others, and their relationship with God. Students and adults discuss how living a Christian life can help guide their future and strengthen relationships with family, friends, and God.

Kairos is a Roman Catholic retreat program for high school and college. Kairos is part of the larger three-day movement in America, ultimately derived from the Cursillo movement founded in Spain in 1944. As such, the retreat is a four-day, three-night residential retreat, with the aim of providing participants the chance to “contemplate God’s role in their lives”. It was first held in 1965, and under its current name since 1979. It is conceptually based in Ignatian spirituality, as put forth in

Senior Retreat - Kairos – Jesuit High School

Kairos is a nationally recognized Catholic retreat program for high school seniors. It is a two-and-a-half day off campus retreat experience. The word Kairos translates here as God’s time, and it is an opportunity for our students to get to know God, themselves and others in a deeper way. This is a student-run retreat in that a core team of 12 seniors who have made their own Kairos are trained to put on the retreat for their peers.

Kairos | Fenwick High School

Kairos Retreat: The Kairos retreat program, a very popular program in so many Catholic high schools throughout the country, is offered to seniors and gives students three-and-a-half days of talks, discussion, prayer and reflection. Students develop greater trust in themselves and others and build a stronger relationship with God.

Retreats - Campus Ministry | Marist High School

Held at Magnificat with visits to Huntington Beach, these retreats guide students to explore their faith and contemplate their relationship with God creatively through the medium of art. Kairos A Greek word meaning “the Lord’s time,” Kairos is an overnight retreat held at the Villa that invites participants to explore God’s presence in their lives through personal sharing and attentive listening.

Retreats - Magnificat High School

Kairos is an optional 4-day retreat that allows participants the chance to deepen their relationships with God, themselves, and one another through reflection, discussion, and prayer. Based on St. Ignatius’s Spiritual Exercises, Kairos is rooted in the Catholic tradition and has been offered in Catholic high schools across the country since the 1980s.

Kairos – Faith Life – John Carroll High School

The Kairos Retreat is a four day, three night residential retreat. A number of students attend, led by a team composed of senior students and staff members. Major talks (each team member presents one) are followed by discussion in small groups.
