Allow the patient to tell their story, Native American history is often passed down orally rather than in written format. A transition from evaluation to therapy and treatment should be a soft hand off to the therapist and psychiatrist. A soft handoff is an integrative practice where the psychiatrist and primary care provider work closely together.

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Many of those facilities only provide primary care, and many American Indians and Alaska Natives don't live near an IHS facility. Medicaid coverage enables this population to get health services outside IHS or tribal facilities as well.
